



The chart below reflects the sequence of courses for core classes and elective space offerings.

- Raleigh County School District students are required to meet the basic state requirements for completion of core subjects as well as a total of 26 credits to graduate high school. Effective for the 2018/19 freshman cohort and thereafter, the minimum number of credits for awarding a standard diploma shall be 24 credits. Raleigh County School District operates on a 6 period day.
